


نمونه 1 IELTS writing task نمره 9 از وبسایت ArmaniEnglish

The graph below shows the proportion of the population aged 65 and over between 1940 and 2040 in three different countries.



The line graph compares the percentage of elderly people in the community over a period of 100 years in Japan, Sweden, and the USA.

Overall, it is evident that the proportion of the elderly increased in each country over the period shown. Although the three countries were similar in terms of a general increase, the USA experienced the fastest growth in the rate of seniors.

In 1940, elderly people in the USA accounted for approximately 10 percent of the population. The figures for Japan and Sweden were lower, at about 5% and 8 % respectively. In 2000, the number of seniors in America and Sweden rose to around 15% of the population, while the figure for Japan remained relatively constant.

By 2040, the figure for Japan is expected to reach almost 28%. The highest figure recorded in the survey, and the rate of old people in Sweden is also predicted to increase to 25% despite a fluctuation from 1980 to 2040. By contrast, it is estimated that the USA will become the country with the smallest elderly percentage with about 24%.
